INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING! SHUT POWER OFF AT FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER.

AVERTISSEMENT! COUPER LE COURANT AU NIVEAU DES FUSIBLES OU DU DISJONCTEUR.

- 1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker box and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts in a clean area. Take care not to misplace any small parts necessary for installation.

ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE (Fig.1)

- 3. Pass the wires of the fixture body (F) through the central rod of canopy (C), and then install the central rod of canopy (C) to the fixture body (F).
- 4. Unscrew the mounting screw (D) from the canopy (C) and detach the mounting plate (A).
- 5. Attach mounting plate (A) to junction box (Not included) using outlet box screws(B) (Size:#8-32N*L1"). The side of the mounting plate (A) marked "GND" must face out.

CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig. 2)

- 6. Connect electrical wires as shown in Fig.2, making sure that all wire connectors are secured. If your junction box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect the ground wire directly to the mounting plate (A) using the green screw (E) provided.
- 7. Tuck wire connectors neatly into the junction box.


COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)

- 8. Position canopy (C) up against ceiling and thread mounting screw (D) to secure fixture to ceiling.
- 9. Install (3) three medium base bulbs (G) up to 60 watts each or CFL or LED equivalent (not included) in accordance with the fixture specification.
- DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!).
- 10. Thread the nipple (H) onto the bottom of the socket of the fixture body(F). Raise the metal washer(J) and plastic washer (K) and glass diffuser (L) over the nipple(H) ,secure with finial (M). Do not over tighten. (You can adjust the length of nipple (H) by adjust the hex nut (I) if necessary.)

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.

Note: Illustration (Fig. 1) on this manual is for installation purposes only. It may or may not be identical to the fixture purchased.

IMPORTANT: FIXTURE SHOULD BE INSTALLED BY A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN TO ENSURE PROPER WIRING AND INSTALLATION.










a. Hardware Bag:
