READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

${f W}$ arning! shut power off at fuse or circuit breaker.

AVERTISSEMENT! COUPER LE COURANT AU NIVEAU DES FUSIBLES OU DU DISJONCTEUR.

- 1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker box and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts in a clean area. Take care not to misplace any small parts necessary for installation.

ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE (Fig.1)

- 3. Unscrew the mounting screw (D) from the canopy (C) and detach the mounting plate (A).
- 4. Attach mounting plate (A) to junction box (not included) using junction box screw (B). The side of mounting plate (A) marked "GND" must face out.
- 5. Determine desired hanging height and thread rods (F/E) on fixture body (G). Pass wires carefully through each rod as you assemble.
- 6. Push fixture wires carefully through the swivel on canopy (C) and secure canopy (C) onto rods (F/E).

CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig. 2)

- 7. Connect electrical wires as shown in Fig.2, making sure that all wire connectors are secured. If your junction box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect the ground wire directly to the mounting plate (A) using the green screw provided.
- 8. Tuck wire connectors neatly into the junction box.

COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)


- 9. Position canopy (C) up against ceiling and thread mounting screw (D) to secure fixture to ceiling.
- 10. Screw glass shade (H) over the socket in the fixture body (G) by using socket ring (I). Do not over tighten.
- 11. Install (1) one medium base bulb (J) up to 60 watts each or CFL or LED equivalent (not included) in accordance with the fixture specification.—**DO**

NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!).

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.

Note: Illustration (Fig. 1) on this manual is for installation purposes only. It may or may not be identical to the fixture purchased.

IMPORTANT: FIXTURE SHOULD BE INSTALLED BY A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN TO ENSURE PROPER WIRING AND INSTALLATION.











a. Hardware Bag:


- A. Mounting plate*1
