# WARNING! SHUT POWER OFF AT FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER.

#### **MOUNTING THE BACKPLATE (Fig.1)**

- 1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker and remove old fixture, including the mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
- Attach the Back-plate (A) to the Junction box with the Junction box Screws (B). The side of the Back-plate marked "GND" must face out.

#### **CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig. 2)**

4. Connect the electrical wires as shown in Fig. 2, making sure that all wire connectors are secured. If your outlet box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's Ground Wire to it. Otherwise, connect the fixture's Ground Wire directly to the Back-plate using the Green Screw provided. After the wires are connected carefully tuck them inside the Junction box.

### **FINISH MOUNTING FIXTURE (Fig.1)**

- Place the Fixture Body (D) over the Back-plate (A), and secure them with Allen Screws (C) tightly by Wrench (H) provided.
- Place Shade (E) upwards against the lamp socket followed by Washer (F) and secure with Screw Shell (G).
- Install light bulb in accordance with fixture specifications, (DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING!)

Your installation is now complete. Return power and test the fixture.
