#### **PREPARATION** (Fig. 1)

- 1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker box and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts in a clean area. Take care not to misplace any small parts necessary for installation.

# ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE (Fig. 1)

- 3. Determine the desired hanging height and thread rods (F1, F2 and F3) to threaded nipple (G) on the fixture body. Attach canopy (D) by screwing onto rod (F1). Carefully pass the wires through each rod during assembly. Note: Remove the threaded nipple, if installing with one 6" rod only.
- 4. Thread screws (A) into the pre-drilled holes in the circular strap (B) spaced the same distance apart as the holes in the canopy (D).
- Attach the circular strap (B) to the outlet box using mounting screws (C) (Size: #8-32N\*L0.5"). The side of the circular strap marked "GND" must face out.

# **CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig. 2)**

- 6. Connect the electrical wires as shown in figure 2, making sure that all wire connectors are secured. If your outlet has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect the fixture's ground wire directly to the circular strap (B) using the green screw provided.
- 7. Tuck the wire connectors neatly into the ceiling outlet box.

# **COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)**

- 8. Slide screws (A) through canopy (D) and secure with decorative nuts (E).
- Install the one G9 bulb (I) (included) up to 75 watts each or CFL or LED equivalent in accordance with the fixture's specifications. (DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING!). (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!).
- 10. Raise the glass shade (J) to socket cup (H) and twist to secure.

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the outlet box and test the fixture.

Note: Illustration (Fig. 1) on this manual is for installation purposes only. It may or may not be identical to the fixture purchased.

IMPORTANT: FIXTURE SHOULD BE INSTALLED BY A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN TO ENSURE PROPER WIRING AND INSTALLATION.
